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Volunteer Dress Code

At FNM, we desire to provide a positive example to all who see us in service to their community. As someone who may be seen to be a representative of FNM, we require that you are actively involved in providing this positive example. Adherence to the dress code, as listed below, will assist us in continually earning the respect of those who we are serving.

WOMEN (13 years and older)

TROUSERS, JEANS, SKIRTS & DRESSES:

- Trousers, jeans, skirts and dresses - knees must be covered, even while seated
- Capri's (3/4 trousers are acceptable)
- Shorts may be worn at appropriate times but they must be knee-length or longer.
- Short may not be worn during home visits or traditional/cultural events whether they are at the FNM Training Center or outside in the greater community.

TOPS:

- No offensive logos or inappropriate wording on T-shirts
- No tight tops, low necklines, or skin showing between top and trousers or skirt
- No spaghetti strap tops.

Sporting Activities: clothing used for sports such as aerobics or running may be tighter fitting than allowed for normal wear. We ask that you change immediately following the activity.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

- **Do** wear a bra; the straps should not be visible
- **Do** wear a petticoat/slip with sheer (see-through) dresses or skirts
- Should you wish to go swimming, swimsuits must be either one-piece or a modest tankini, you may also need to wear a t-shirt and/or board shorts, *i.e.: no high cut legs and no visible skin between the top and bottom*

MEN (13 years and older)

TROUSERS, JEANS, SHORTS:

- Long trousers or jeans are the general rule of thumb.
- Shorts are to be knee-length or longer
- Shorts may NOT be worn home visits or traditional/cultural events whether they are at the FNM Training Center or outside in the greater community.

TOPS:

- No offensive logos or inappropriate wording on T-shirts
- No tank tops with deep armholes

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

- Boxer or shorts style swim-trunks are recommended.

FOR CHURCH

Ladies:

Dresses/skirts (with shoulders & knees covered) have long been the appropriate attire in churches; however, some of the local churches are more accepting of jeans & t-shirts as long as they are not tight fitting and that no skin is showing between the top and pants.

Men:

Smart-casual or even formal wear (trousers and shirts) are generally the more appropriate style of dress for church, but jeans are becoming more acceptable, as long as they are not torn.
